MEMORANDUM OF THE SOCIETY

1. Name of the Society: Gouthami Educational Society
2. Location of the Office : D.No: 9-21, Hanuman Nagar, Boduppall,
Opp: Uppal Bus Depot., R.R.Dist., HYD-39.
ANDHRA PRADESH.

Official Language : The official language of the Society shall be English or Telugu.

3. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY :**

The aims and objectives of the Society are as follows :

1. To promote and spread General Education Primary in rural areas for boys and girls and particularly providing training of the students appearing for The various Courses and particularly Medical, Engineering And professional courses, P.G. Courses etc..
2. To arrange scientific, cultural and educational exhibitions, lectures, etc., to create interest in the students in such matters that would be helped for their individual developments as well as the welfare of the society.
3. To run technical schools/colleges/institutions and hold seminars for imparting necessary education to the students in rural areas.
4. To undertake such other activities and run institutions as would be decided from time to time by the governing body of the society. The society shall have a governing body with a President, Secretary, Vice-President, Joint Secretary, Treasurer and nominate executive members as may be found necessary in all 7, including those that would be nominated by the All India Council Technical Education/University/ State Govt. Director of Technical Education who will be (ex-officio) and Director.
5. To provide deep knowledge in computers and Information's Technology.
6. To conduct research activities related to the development of engineering and technology and to support short and long-term activities, thereof.
7. To develop and propagate intermediate education and technology for rural development.
8. To promote career based education.



9. To publish and codify books and manuals.
10. The Society is formed with no profit motive no agitational activity is involved by the working and that the Office Bearers are not paid from the funds of the Association.

MEMORANDUM OF THE SOCIETY

- 1- Name of the Society : Gouthami Educational Society.
2. Location of the Office : D.No:9-21,Hanuman Nagar,Boduppal,Opp: Uppal Bus Depot, Hyderabad-39,Andhra Pradesh.
3. Membership : All Persons above 21 years.
4. **CATEGORY OF MEMBERSHIP** : The Society shall consist of the following categories of members
 - i) Founder Member
 - ii) Life Member
 - iii) Nominated Member
 - iv) Honorary Member
 - i) **Founder Member**: The members who have signed the document at the time of registration are founder members. Every founder member must nominate his/her successor.
 - ii) **Life Member** : A Life member is a person who contributes a sum of Rs.1,00,016/- (Rupees one lakh sixteen only) to the society in lump sum.
 - iii) **Nominated Member** : The nominated members are those members who are nominated by founder members in the event of their death, the founder member is free to inform the name of the nominee in writing to the society. The general body is final authority to examine the nominated candidates at the time of admission as per society rule.
5. **EX-OFFICIO MEMBER: (without voting right)**
The principal or the director of each college run by the society.
6. **ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR LIFE MEMBERSHIP** :
 - i). Any person having completed the age of 21 years and with Marathi as
 - ii) Application for admission to the life member of the society should be in the prescribed form and shall be duly recommended by at least tow members of society. Who have a standing of not less than three years as a member of the Society or founder members.
 - iii) All Application should be accompanied by a receipt of payment of prescribed amount and must be addressed to the Secretary.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- i. The Executive Committee consists of five members namely
a) President b) Vice-President c) Secretary d) Jt. Secretary e) Treasurer
- ii. The General Body may nominate one of two members to be members of executive committee as may be formed necessary.
- iii. The term of the Executive Committee shall be three years from the date of the first meeting of the newly elected executive committee but the members of the Executive committee shall be eligible for re-election.
- iv. The Executive Committee may, ordinarily meet once in three months and at any rate not less than four times in a year.
- v. A notice of clear seven days for an ordinary Executive Committee meeting and a notice of clear 3 days for an emergency Executive Committee meeting shall be given to the members by personally or by Registered post or by Certificate of Posting.
- vi. Any matter requiring urgent action may be circulated among the members, with the permission of the President for their consideration and such circular resolution be place before the Executive Committee at its next meeting for ratification.
- vii. It shall be incumbent on the Executive Committee to cause the elections to be held before the end of their terms of office. In case no elections are held before the hold or for a period of 6 months form the date of expiry of their term of office, whichever is earlier.
- viii. The president shall preside over all the meetings of the Executive committee and General Body. In his absence, vice President shall take the chair at these meetings. In the absence of President and Vice-President, any other members of the Executive Committee present, may be requested to chair the meeting.
- ix. The quorum for the Executive Committee meeting shall be $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total members of Executive Committee.
- x. Any vacancy in the Executive Committee due to any reason whatever, shall be filled in by nominations from the members of the society by the remaining members of the Executive Committee. Such a nominated member shall hold office for the un expired period of the outgoing members.




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xi. Any member of the Executive Committee who is absent for three consecutive meetings without intimation shall cease to be a member of the Executive committee.

xii. A notice of seven clear days shall be give to the members for the extraordinary general body meeting. The notice shall specify date, time place and business to be transacted.

xiii. No business other than the business included in the notice convening the meeting shall be discussed in the meeting except with the permission of the presiding officer.

- iv) The Secretary shall place these applications before the meeting of the executive committee for its consideration. The executive committee shall have the right to reject the application. Without assigning any reason whatsoever. However, if an application is rejected, the amount paid by the person towards admission fee for membership shall be refunded to him. The decision of the Executive Committee in such matters shall be final.
- v) The member may appoint his proxy to attend the meetings on his behalf. But the proxy can attend the meetings only after approval of the Executive committee. The Executive committee have the right to deny any member nominee to attend the meetings without any reason whatsoever.

7. THE ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE SOCIETY SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS

- A. General Body
- b. Executive Committee

A) **GENERAL BODY :** The General body shall consist of all members of the society belonging to different categories.

Composition : The General Body shall consist of all members of the society belonging to different categories.

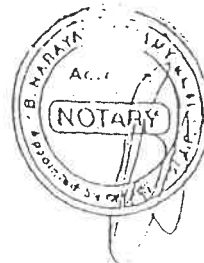
Meeting : The meeting of the General Body shall be held at least once in a year before the end of June.

Quorum : The quorum for the General Body meeting shall be half of the total Members.

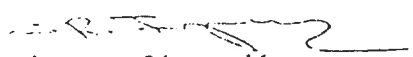
For want of quorum or otherwise the meeting shall be adjourned to a subsequent date not earlier than two days. In such an adjourned meeting business will be transacted either without quorum.

POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE GENERAL BODY

- i. To elect the following 5 office Bearers from the General Body.
 - a) President b) Vice-President c) General Secretary Jt. Secretary
 - e) Treasurer
- ii. To consider and approve the audited statements of accounts and annual report of the society.
- iii. To consider and approve the budget of the society.



- iv. To appoint and fix remuneration of the auditor of the Society.
- v. To consider and lay down general policy matters regarding the affairs of the society.
- vi. To bring about any amendment to the constitution of the society.
- vii. To consider and approve any matter referred to it by the Governing Council.

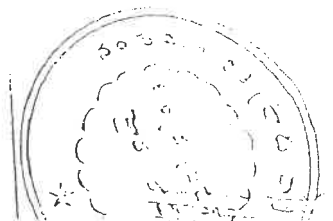

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Subject to the provisions of this constitution and of the decisions of the General Body the Executive Committee shall manage, and administer all the affairs of the Society and shall have, the following powers.

- i. To admit, suspend, remove any members or accept the resignation of any member of the Society.
- ii. To take decisions on application for memberships.
- iii. To prepare and formulate the annual budget of the society submit the same to the General Body for its consideration and approval.
- iv. To appropriate and re-appropriate the budget allocations as may be required from time to time.
- v. To appoint person to various posts and fix their salary or remuneration as per rules. And also to remove, suspend, punish a person who is an employee of the society on adequate grounds and reasons as per rules formed by the Govt./university from time to time, if any.
- vi. To appoint sub-committees for the proper functioning of the society and also of the various institutions run by the society.
- vii. To accept donations, and to take necessary measure to raise funds for the society.
- viii. To place before the general body, the annual report of the society and the audited statement of accounts together with Auditor's Report of the Society.
- ix. To take all necessary or desirable steps in the interests of the Society to achieve the objectives of the Society.
- x. To sue and defend all legal proceedings on behalf of the society.
- xi. To open account/accounts in any scheduled bank/banks as may be decided by Executive Committee.
- xii. To make, adopt and change from time to time bye-laws for the regulation of and for any purposes connected with the management and administration of the affairs of the Society.



POWERS OF PRESIDENT:

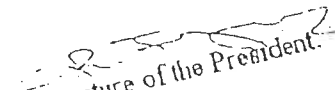
- i. The president shall exercise General Supervision of over all affairs of the society.
- ii. The president shall preside over the meetings of the Executive Committee and General Body.
- iii. To raise any loans required for the development of the collages relating to the society or sponsored by the society.
- iv. To deposit / Pledge / Mortgage societies fixed assets against loans / securities etc.,.

9. POWERS OF VICE-PRESIDENT:

- i. The Vice-President shall assist the President in performing his duties.
- ii. In the absence of the president, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the president and shall exercise the same powers.

10. POWERS OF SECRETARY:

- i. The Secretary shall carryout all decisions and directives of the General Body and Executive Committee.
- ii. He shall manage the day to day working of the Society. He shall have in particular, the following powers:
- iii. To maintain all correspondence letters and documents issue notice of the meetings, to sign all papers and to receive the collections etc., of the Society.

- a. To Place all important correspondence suggestions, information etc., before the Executive Committee for its consideration.
- b. To ensure that rules and regulations of the Society are properly adhered to and to bring to the notice of the Governing Council any violation in respect thereof.
- c. To report the damage etc., to the properties of the Society, if any to the Executive Committee.
- d. To supervise the work of the employees of the Society.
- e. To prepare the annual budget and the annual report of Society and place it before the Executive Committee for its consideration.
- f. To incur any expenditure at his discretion as may be necessary not exceeding Rs.3000/- (Rupees three thousand only) at any time pending the approval of Executive Committee.

To hold and sign documents. Enter into agreements etc., relating to the Society with the third party.

To present the Society in all official matters or legal actions for or against the Society.

To maintain or cause to be maintained all the registers, account books etc., and to cause the audit of the income and expenditure accounts of the Society.

To call a meetings of the executive committee and General Body.

To record and maintain the minutes of the meetings and other transactions of the Executive Committee and General Body.

- g. To open account in any nationalised/scheduled bank any where in A.P.
- h. To raise any loan required for the development of the Colleges by the Society.
- i. To Deposit/Pledge/Mortgage societies fixed assets against loans/securities etc.,
- p. To nominate correspondents for the colleges of the society.

12. POWERS OF JOINT SECRETARY:

1. The joint secretary shall assist the secretary in the discharge of his duties. In the absence of the secretary, Joint secretary shall act as the secretary.



13. POWERS OF TREASURE :

- i. To supervise the Income and Expenditure of the Society and to report to the Secretary.

14. POWERS OF OFFICE BEARERS :

- i. They are responsible persons to do the activities of the Society which the Executive Committee entrusted to them.

15. VOTING OF RESOLUTIONS :

All the resolutions of the General Body and the Executive Committee shall be passed, by majority of members those present, in case of a tie, the chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote, which shall decide the issue finally.

QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY :

A member of the society shall incur disqualification and shall be liable to be removed from the rolls of the society on any of the following grounds.

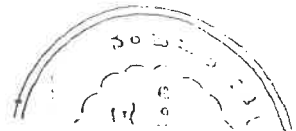
- i. A member who is convicted by a competent court of Authority for any offense involving moral turpitude.
- ii. A member who violates or contravenes the provisions of the constitution or any rules and regulations framed by the Executive Committee. Provided that no member shall be deemed to have incurred disqualification under above clause under a resolution to that effect I passe; by two thirds of the total members of the Executive Committee shall be final. It shall not be obligatory for the Governing Council to assign any reason for arriving at such a decision.

Provided that no resolution under this clause shall be passed without the member being given an opportunity to explain and make representation, if any, to the Executive Committee.

17. FUNDS

The funds and finances of the society comprises of:

- i. Donation from the members
- ii. Membership subscription
- iii. Donations from the public
- iv. Aid from other sources
- v. The Funds shall be spent only attainment the objects of the Society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to any of its members through any means.



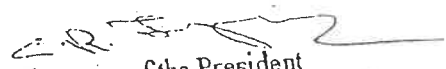
18. MAINTENANCE OF ACCOUNTS : The Secretary and Treasurer will jointly maintains the accounts. These two persons shall sign cheques and operate bank accounts.

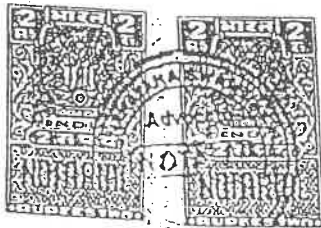
19. AMENDMENTS :

1. No amendment or alterations shall be made on the purpose of Society unless it is voted it is voted by 2/3rd of its members present at a special general body meeting convened for the purpose and confirmed by 2/3rd of the members present at a second special meeting.
2. The aims and objectives of the society, as set forth in object clause may be amended, extended or on a proposal and approval from the General Body, however, any such alteration/modification for amendment that, shall not have the effect of violating provisions of society Act or section 80(G) of the Income Tax act or any statutory modifications there of for the time being in force, and prior approval of the commissioner of Income Tax shall be obtained.

20. WINDING UP :

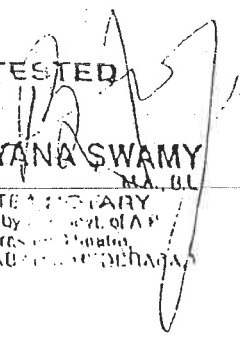
